## Papal Visit

As you know the Pope is coming to visit the UK in September and arrangements are well underway in organising this historic event. There are two separate events which if you want to take part you must have a Pilgrim pass. They are the Hyde Park Prayer Vigil on Saturday 18 September and the Beatification Mass in Birmingham on Sunday 19 September. We have at the moment been allotted 20 places for Birmingham and 93 spaces for Hyde park. We have been asked to choose a parishioner who will participate in the Vigil in Hyde Park by carrying our Parish banner in as part of the ceremony. They will need to be fit, able to stand and walk some distance carrying the banner. They also need to attend a day in Central London on 18 September in preparation. If you would be interested please do let me know asap. We also need to appoint a Pilgrim Leader for both Birmingham and Hyde Park, they must be good administrators and be able to receive and send email.
